At Atlantic Acting School, we equip our students with the physical, emotional, and analytical tools of acting to discover their truths, and prepare them for success beyond our doors. From our full-time and evening conservatory to our after school and summer programs for kids and teens, our immersive, learn-by-doing approach is central to an Atlantic Acting education. We have mentored and trained outstanding artists for more than 30 years. No matter their age or background, our students learn to break through their creative comfort zones in service to bringing essential human stories to life. Inspire the next generation of theater-makers by supporting our arts education initiatives which reach over 5,000 students in programs like our student matinees or Staging Success - which brings theater into an academic setting and emboldens students to put their own stories onstage.

For almost 35 years, Atlantic has been unafraid to produce simple and honest stories that challenge and transform our ways of thinking. Our longstanding history of highcaliber, daring theater has brought some of the greatest stories to the stage, including Spring Awakening and The Band's Visit. Atlantic is a powerhouse producer of new work in the NYC community, earning 22 Tony Awards and coveted Lucille Lortel and Drama Desk Awards for "Outstanding Body of Work." Each season, we produce six intrepid plays and musicals and two Atlantic for Kids productions that reach as many as 55,000 theatergoers. Immerse yourself in world premieres from established writers like Dominique Morisseau, Rajiv Joseph, and Martin McDonagh. Challenge yourself with new plays by emerging artists like Lauren Yee, Ngozi Anyanwu, and Eboni Booth.
